**Keynote Speakers:** 

Dr. Devender Sharma( Prof. Dept of Commerce) Himachal Pradesh University delivered keynote

address on the contemporary theme of Language and communication through pertinent examples from

the discourses of media and communication. He emphasized on the theme of "medium is the message

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and highlighted the role of language and communication in the today's visual electronic media. He quoted from the works of Cutlip and Center and stressed on the Seven Cs of effective communication in their theory Effective Public Relations. The model is well established and accepted. The emphasis of their model of Seven Cs reveals that the communicator must be accomplishing all seven features to be effective communicator which is quite relevant. Prof. Sharma's valuable insight and expertise tremendously enhanced the overall quality of the seminar.

The second speaker, Dr. Rajesh Dhorta, Principal, Govt. College, Kumarsain, Shimla in his session addressed the role and challenges of education in National Education Policy. He highlighted the major role that digitization and technology will play in the field of education and also mentioned that the National Education Policy 2020 represents a significant shift in the education system in India, with a focus on holistic development, flexibility, and the integration of technology. It aims to address the changing needs of the 21st century and make education more inclusive and relevant. • Establishes an Academic Bank of Credit to facilitate the transfer of credits between institutions.

### 3. National Research Foundation (NRF):

• Establishment of the National Research Foundation to promote a culture of research and innovation.

### 4. Autonomy for Higher Education Institutions:

 Greater autonomy for colleges and universities to foster academic and administrative innovation.

#### 5. Phased Implementation:

• The policy outlines a phased implementation strategy, with a focus on ensuring universal access, equity, quality, and affordability in education.

#### 6. Technology Integration:

 Encourages the use of technology in education, including online and digital learning resources.




